Welcome to Algebra! Below is a list of the procedures for the classroom, homework policies, information about tests/quizzes, extra-help days, grading, and contact information. The following information will allow us to have a successful school year! Please review the following information with a parent/guardian and return it signed by September 7th.

Classroom procedures: All students are expected to follow the procedures listed below, along with those that are listed in the student handbook. If students fail to comply with the rules of the classroom it will result in staying after school, a phone call home, or further consequences.

- 1) Always show respect for everyone in the class. Treat others as you would want to be treated.
- 2) Do not talk while someone else is talking.
- 3) Come to class with ALL materials (including homework assignments).
- 4) Students are expected to be on time, in their seat, and working on the "DO NOW" when the bell rings.
- 5) Absolutely no calculators, or cell phones are allowed in class.
- 6) Students are expected to be in their full uniform at all times.
- 7) Students are expected to participate in prayers at the beginning of each class.

Homework policies: Students will be assigned homework on a regular basis. It must be fully completed and in class on the day it is due. Any student who fails to complete a homework assignment will lose 3 points off of their homework average each time. After the third missed homework the student will need to stay after school to complete the assignment. No late homework will be accepted for credit unless a student is absent on the day the homework is assigned. In this case, homework is due the day after they return from being absent. It is the responsibility of the student to show me any missed assignments due to absences. **School retreats do not count as absences and all assignments are due when a student is on retreat.**

Tests and quizzes: For **most** quizzes students will have 1-3 days notice. Any student who is absent on the day of a test or quiz will be expected to make an appointment with me to make it up as soon as possible. The test dates for the year are listed below. You will be notified if there are any changes.

Trimester I Tests: 9/21, 10/5, 10/26, 11/8, 11/22, 12/9, 12/21

Trimester II Tests: 1/12, 1/25, 2/8, 3/2, 3/17, 3/30, 4/10

Trimester III Tests: 5/8, 5/18, 6/2, 6/15

Extra-help: Extra help will be held every morning in room 106 (my homeroom) from 7:45-8:05. If students need additional help, they can set up a time to meet with me.

Grading: The following grading system will be used:

Homework, Quizzes, Classwork – 1/3 of grade
Exams – 1/3 of grade
Trimester Exam – 1/3 of grade

iPad Usage: Students are required to have their iPad in class with them each day. The iPad is expected to be fully charged for the beginning of each school day. A student will not receive credit for work if their iPad is not in class or is unable to be used, due to lack of charging. Any student using their iPad in class, for other purposes except math, will face disciplinary action. Students are expected to have a pencil with them each day for pop quizzes, scheduled quizzes, and tests.
